

DOMESTIC AND SEXUAL VIOLENCE IN 2019



a physical injury registered every

267,930 records of physical injury as a result of of domestic violence



1 rape every 8 minutes **66,348** victims of rape and rape of vulnerable **58.8%** of victims 13 years old and younger **85.7%** female


