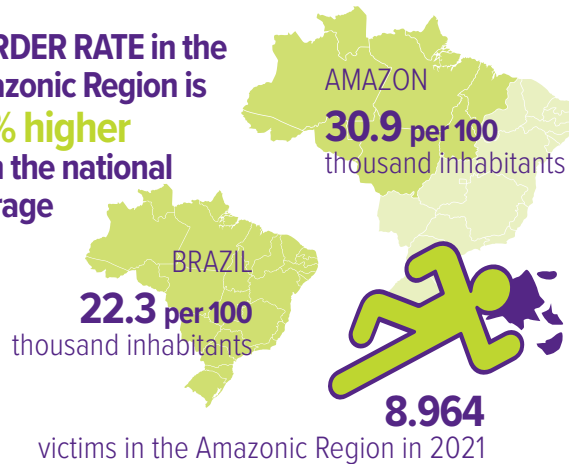
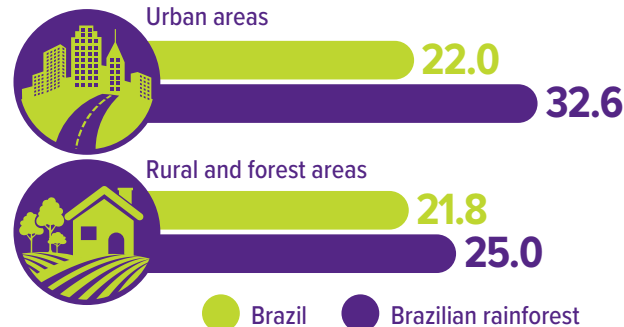


VIOLENCE IN THE BRAZILIAN AMAZON RAINFOREST

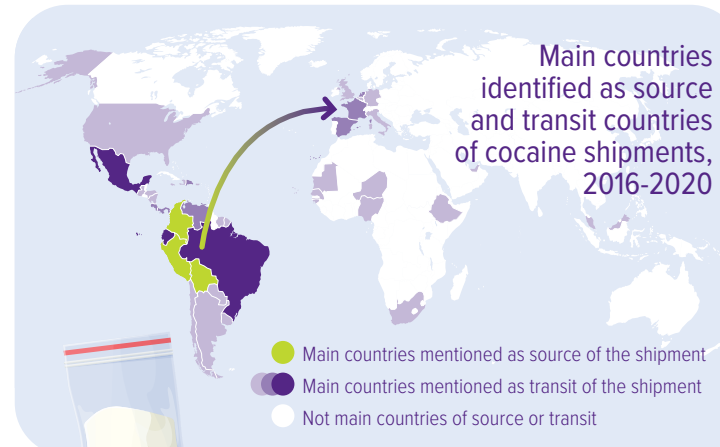


ADVANCE of deforestation and the **INTENSIFICATION** of land conflicts

50% of this production goes through Brazil, having **Europe** as its main destination for domestic consumption

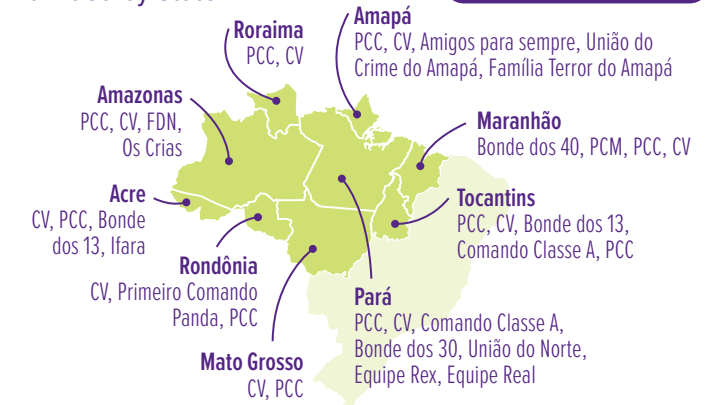


The revenue generated by drug trafficking is estimated to be as huge as **4% of the Brazilian GDP**
